

PHOTOSHOP –

from the beginning to more advanced

Ages: KS3 to adult .

Class size: Maximum 20.

Duration: One day.

Cost: £200 + travel expenses.

Please note: All workshops can be adapted to suit individual requirements.

Key Processes include:

Art and Design – consideration of a career in the cultural industries or vocational practice; appreciation of crafts as well as new technologies; original thinking and creativity; decision making of media choices, technique and process; careful analysis and evaluation of their work; careful planning and vision; risk taking.

Details:

Students will work with digital images to produce an exciting, manipulated, original digital file. These workshops encompass old methodology as well as new technology. I ensure students think about what they want to achieve first, before letting the computer do the work.

Photoshop has infinite possibilities and ways of utilising it's capabilities, there is never just one way to achieve one's goal. The abilities and ambitions of the individuals will be taken in to account as the workshop progresses, at the end of which students will be able to produce an image that has been enhanced by various methods using their own creativity.

We will run from the very beginning. Students will learn about page sizes and image quality, tools, filters, importing an image, layers, saving images, printing.
